Creation of Committee:

Ragging means the doing of any act which causes, or is likely to cause any physical, psychological or physiological harm of apprehension or shame or embarrassment to a student, and includes teasing or abusing of playing Practical joke on, or causing hurt to any student.

Asking any student to do any act, or perform anything, which he/she would not, in the ordinary course, be willing to do or perform.

In view of the directions of the Honourable Supreme Court in SLP No. 24295 of 2006 dated 16-05-2007 and in Civil Appeal No. 887 of 2009, dated 08-05-2009, to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 23 read with Section 10(b), (g), (p) and (g) of AICTE Act, 1987, the All India Council for Technical Education has notified regulations for prevention and prohibition of ragging in AICTE approved Technical Institutions vide No. 37-3/Legal /AICTE/2009 dated 01.07.2009.

Keeping in view the need to prevent Ragging and as per the provisions of AICTE APH 2021, the college constitutes Anti-Ragging Committee.

The following are the objectives and responsibilities of the committee:

Objectives: To prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging including any conduct by any student whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student, or indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by any student.

To monitor, direct and oversee the functions and performance of the Anti-Ragging Squads in prevention and curbing of ragging in the institution.

- To be vigilant at all hours all around the campus and other places vulnerable to incidents of and having the potential of, ragging and shall be empowered to inspect such places.
- To make surprise raids at other places vulnerable to incidents and having the potential for ragging.
 - To conduct an on-the-spot enquiry into any incident of ragging referred to it by the faculty or
- student or parent or guardian, as the case may be: and the enquiry report along with recommendations shall be submitted to the Head of the Institution for action.
 - To ensure the display of posters on Institution and Department Notice Boards and other prominent designated places.
 - The Anti-Ragging Squad regularly makes rounds in the campus to effectively monitor the students behaviour in the campus.
 - To offer services of counselling and create awareness to the students on the evils of Ragging.
